Fitness center *re-named*

SAN BERNARDINO — More than 75 people attended the rededication ceremony this week of the St. Bernardine Medical Center's fitness center honoring two longtime hospital and St. Bernardine Foundation benefactors.

The fitness center, which will help those recovering from cardiac or orthopedic surgery, is being renamed as a tribute to husband and wife, Dana and Delia Weaver.

The Weaver Health and Fitness Center offers state-of-the-art exercise equipment with ready access to medical help, hospital officials said.

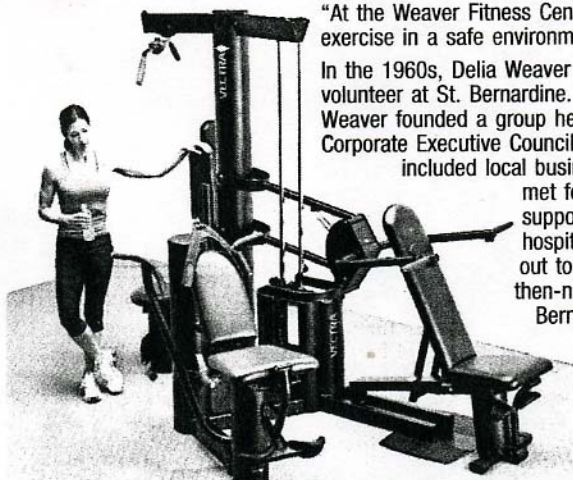
"If you work out at a chain fitness club, you have access to equipment," said Drew Gagner, the foundation's president. "But if you are recovering from surgery or a heart condition, you are not working out within shouting distance of a myriad of medical specialists.

"At the Weaver Fitness Center, people can exercise in a safe environment."

In the 1960s, Delia Weaver was a volunteer at St. Bernardine. In 1985, Dana Weaver founded a group he named the Corporate Executive Council. The group included local businessmen who

met for breakfast, supported the hospital and worked out together at the then-named St.

Bernardine Cardiac Fitness Center.
